# Board of Education Goals 2022-2023

St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES is committed to work successfully with component districts across the region:

Shall the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of the Sole Supervisory District of St. Lawrence and Lewis Counties (the "BOCES") be authorized to sell to the County of St. Lawrence the former White Hill Tower and grounds consisting of 4 +/- acres located at 2695 White Hill Road in the Town of Hopkinton for the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and upon terms to be approved by the BOCES to be used by the County of St. Lawrence for the purposes of emergency services.
