# Board of Education Goals 2023-2024

St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES is committed to work successfully with component districts across the region:

- To increase student performance and enhance opportunities to access advanced coursework essential for a successful preparation for college, career, and citizenship including alternative and technology-based platforms
- To promote regional sharing and delivery models through inter-BOCES as well as intra-BOCES arrangements
- To continuously evaluate BOCES services for quality, efficiency, and potential improvement, including input from our component school district partners
- To provide financial and operational solutions to our component school districts helping them maximize new revenue sources, and specifically to provide training and build school district preparedness for lean times due to reductions of federal and state aid.

#### St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES will:

- Work with our Regional Partners, including SUNY Potsdam, to build and refine regional pipelines that will produce teachers and future educational leaders for the region, including the Ed Leadership Program at SUNY Potsdam and the Advanced Certificate in Special Education Program, and the District Superintendents' Innovation Committee and BOCES of NYS Teacher Ambassador Program.
- Work with component districts to provide professional development of a multi-year implementation of The Science of Reading to address significant literacy gaps across the region.
- Continue to provide school districts and BOCES staff the information, resources, and training necessary to protect digital information, including Personally Identifiable Information (PII) of staff/students, and to protect our technology platforms.
- Develop resources to support BOCES and SLL component districts as they raise awareness and build capacity toward the implementation of the New York State Education Department's Culturally Responsive Sustaining Education Framework and the embedded components of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.
- Begin a comprehensive review of regional Special Education programs and classes, both BOCES and school district, with an eye towards future restructuring.

VI. <u>2024-2025 BOCES Administrative, Program and Capital Budget</u>
(In accordance with <u>Board Policy #1310</u> – Power and Duties of the Board and Its Officers; with <u>Board Policy #4110</u> – Budget Planning and Preparation; and Board Policy #4210 – Investments)

Rationale:

Component Boards of Education met on Tuesday, April 22, 2024, the date designated by BOCES Board President to vote on the BOCES Administrative Budget and three BOCES board terms. The Administrative budget was approved by all 18 component school boards voting in favor. James Lattimer, Ward Remington and Dr. John "Jack" Zeh were elected to the three, three-year board terms – July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2027.

A motion is needed to adopt the 2024-2025 BOCES Administrative, Program, and Capital Budget as presented and approved by the component schools' boards of education.

A motion is needed to approve the Personnel as presented in Attachment "A".

VIII. Lease with the Ogdensburg Boys and Girls Club

(In accordance with Board Policy #4510 – Facilities Planning)

A motion is needed to approval of the one-year lease agreement between the Ogdensburg Boys' and Girls' Club and St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES. The premise to be utilized is described as the gymnasium and game room located at 610 Patterson Street, Ogdensburg, NY. The term of the agreement shall be \$7,000 for the period of September 5, 2024 - June 19, 2025.

## IX. BOCES Annual Meeting Date

Rationale:

The date must meet the requirements of the Laws of 1993 – BOCES Reform Act, which states a meeting of the members of the board of education and school trustees of the component school districts shall be held during the month of April on or before the fifteenth day of April, on a date and place and hour designated by the present of the board of cooperative educational services (Ed. Law §1950)

A motion is needed to set the 2025 Annual Meeting date for the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES. The date will be Thursday, April 10, 2025.

X. Set Date for Component Districts Vote on BOCES Administrative Budget and Board Vacancies for 2025 (In accordance with Board Policy #1220 – Nomination and Election of Board Members)

Rationale: Pursuant to §1950, subdivision 2-a(b) of the Education Law of the State of New York (in compliance with the BOCES Reform Legislation, 1993), the president of the BOCES shall designate a single date on or after the 16th date and on or before the 30th date of April on which each component board shall conduct a public meeting which may be a regular or special meeting, for the purpose of electing members of the BOCES and adopting a public resolution concerning the approval of disapproval of the tentative administrative budget.

A motion is needed to set the date of Tuesday, April 29, 2025, on which each component school district shall conduct a public meeting for the purpose of electing members of the BOCES and adopting a resolution concerning the approval or disapproval of the tentative administrative budget.

XI. Solid Waste Disposal Service (In accordance with Board Policy #4310 – Purchasing Policy)

> A motion is needed to approve the three-year mutually agreed upon bid extension for Solid Waste Disposal Service to Casella Waste Services, Inc., July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027.

A motion is needed to approve the following emergency projects:

- Southwest Technical Center hot water system repair the condition required immediate corrective action and could not wait execution of proper bidding procedures due to the environmental concerns.
- Seaway Technical Center sanitary sewer pump station repair the condition required immediate corrective action and could not wait execution of proper bidding procedures due to the environmental concerns.

A motion is needed to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, It is the plan of a number of BOCES districts in New York, to consent to jointly enter into an agreement for the 2024-2025 fiscal year for Air Tutors, BookNook Inc., Brainfuse Inc., Desire to Learn, Edmentum, eDoctrina, Educere, Florida Virtual School, Focal Point, Focus Care, Fuel Education, Imagine Learning, Instructure, iTutor.com, Kaltura, MGRM Pinnacle, My VR Spot, Panapto, Paper Education America, Pearson, PowerSchool, Remind 101 Inc., Right Reason, Spider Learning, Tutor Me Education, Varsity Tutors for Schools, and,

WHEREAS, The St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES is desirous of participating with other BOCES Districts in New York State in joint agreements for the distance learning student courses mentioned above as authorized by General Municipal Law, Section 119-0, and,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Board of Education authorizes Erie 1 BOCES to represent it in all matters leading up to and entering into a contract for the purchase of and licensing of the above mentioned courses, and record training sessions in Zoom and post those recorded sessions to the consortium, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Board of Education agrees to assume its equitable share of the costs associated with Erie 1 BOCES negotiating the Agreements, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Board of Education agrees (1) to abide by majority decisions of the participating BOCES on quality standards; (2) Erie 1 BOCES will negotiate contracts according to the majority recommendations; (3) that after contract agreement, it will conduct all purchasing arrangements directly with the vendor.

#### XIV. Installment Purchases

Rationale: The Board of Education finds and determines that it is in St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES'

best financial interest to acquire the equipment for the benefit of the District because:

Hammond Central School for one (1) network printers with Advanced Business Services in the amount of \$4,993.00. The Hammond Central School District approved the installment purchase at their April 22, 2024 Board of Education meeting.

The equipment is being purchased through CoSer 506, Instructional Technology. In accordance with NYS Education Law, installment purchases require approval by board resolution and approval by the State Education Department.
