SUBJECT: TEMPORARY AND PART-TIME EMPLOYEES

The District Superintendent is authorized to fill vacant positions on a temporary or parttime basis, and to fill encumbered positions on a substitute basis, when such positions are necessary for the maintenance or continuity of a program or service.

Temporary Employees

POLICY

Upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent, mid-year vacancies may be filled on a temporary basis for the remainder of the school year. Temporary employees shall satisfy the minimum qualification requirements established by New York State Civil Service and Education Law.

Part-Time Employees in Positions Requiring Certification

In order to meet the education needs of the BOCES and upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent, individuals may be employed on a part-time basis in administrative or instructional positions requiring New York State Education certification. Anyone employed for less than the regular full-time schedule for the classification is considered part-time and shall not accrue any seniority, except in the event of an involuntary reduction from full-time to part-time.

Part-Time Employees in Classified Civil Service Positions

Upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent, individuals may be employed on a part-time basis in classified New York State Civil Service positions. Anyone employed for 50% or less of the regular full-time weekly schedule for the classification is considered part-time and shall not accrue any seniority.

Substitute Employees

Upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent and with the approval of the BOCES Board, a listing of substitute employees will be maintained for the purpose of filling encumbered positions on a per diem basis.

Upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent and with the approval of the BOCES Board, long-term substitutes may be appointed to fill encumbered positions for which leaves of absence have been granted. A long-term substitute is one employed for more than twenty-five (25) consecutive work days in a specific instructional position.
