SUBJECT: STUDENT CONDUCT

The goal of the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES discipline policy is to ensure the right of all students to a productive educational environment in which they may learn the social skills appropriate to their development into mature, responsible adults accountable for their own actions.

The teacher should resolve any minor problems that may arise with students in class. Teachers are instructed to contact their administrators or building administrator in the event of serious child behavior problems. In crises, where time is essential, the building principal should take whatever action is appropriate to resolve an emergency situation. In cases of Special Education students, the Special Education Division should be notified of the action taken.

Minor or "normal" crises, as well as emergencies of various types, should be handled by the building administrator or the home school principal in Career and Technical Education classes if appropriate. The Program Director shall be notified as soon as possible of this occurrence. Administrative staff are available to the teacher in the event of a major crisis in child behavior that necessitates supervisory intervention.
