- Northwest Technical Center AAA Building (Community Connections) water damage issues causing the need for drywall repair and replacement of two 30-year old forced air furnace units – occupation of the building is suspended until repairs are completed – the condition required immediate corrective action and could not await execution of proper bidding procedures due to the environmental concerns.
- Southwest Technical Center sewage line damages the condition required immediate corrective action and could not await execution of proper bidding procedures due to the environmental concerns.
