WHEREAS, the St. Lawrence-Lewis Board of Cooperative Educational Services (“the BOCES”) is desirous of leasing unneeded facilities and is subject to New York State Education Law § 1950 and corresponding Commissioner’s Regulation 155.14; and

WHEREAS, the Development Authority of the North Country (“DANC”) and the BOCES are desirous of entering into a lease agreement.

WHEREAS, among other things, the lease agreement specifies that DANC shall only use the leased facilities for purposes permitted by the Consolidated Laws of New York, Public Authorities Law Ch. 43-A, Article 8, Title. 29 (“the development authority of the north country act”).

WHEREAS, the BOCES has made a study and does not anticipate a need for the leased property during the term of the proposed lease; and

WHEREAS, the BOCES has determined that the annual amount of rental payment is not less than the fair market rental value; and

WHEREAS, BOCES has determined that such lease is in the best educational and financial interest of the board.

WHEREAS, the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES participates in the New York State Teachers' Retirement System ("TRS"); and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2005, the Board of Education of the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES by resolution established a Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund known as the Reserve for Retirement Contributions pursuant to Section 6-r of the General Municipal Law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined it is also appropriate to establish a sub-fund within said Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund pursuant to Section 6-r of the General Municipal Law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES, pursuant to Section 6-r of the General Municipal Law, as follows:

1. The Board hereby establishes a sub-fund within the Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund to be known as the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES TRS Retirement Contribution Reserve Sub-Fund;
2. The source of funds for this Reserve Sub-Fund shall be:

- a. such amounts as may be provided therefore by budgetary appropriation;
 - b. such revenues as are not required by law to be paid into any other fund or account;
 - c. such other funds as may be legally appropriated; and
 - d. such amounts the St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Board of Education may designate from programs at the end of each fiscal year.
3. By resolution, the Board of Education may authorize expenditures from this Reserve Sub-Fund. Except as otherwise provided by law, moneys in this Reserve Sub-Fund may only be appropriated to finance retirement contributions to the New York State Teachers' Retirement System, and/or to offset all or a portion of the amount deducted from the moneys apportioned to the BOCES from the State for the support of schools pursuant to Section 521 of the Education Law.
4. No member of the Board of Education or employee of the BOCES shall:
 - a. authorize a withdrawal from this Reserve Sub-Fund for any purpose except as provided in Section 6-r of the General Municipal Law; or
 - b. expend any money withdrawn from this Reserve Sub-Fund for a purpose other than as provided in Section 6-r of the General Municipal Law.
5. The moneys contributed annually to the Reserve Sub-Fund shall not exceed 2% of the total compensation or salaries of all teachers (as that term is defined in Education Law §501[4]) employed by the BOCES who are members of TRS paid during the immediately preceding fiscal year.
6. The balance of the Reserve Sub-Fund shall not exceed 10% of the total compensation or salaries of all teachers (as that term is defined in Education Law §501[4]) employed by the BOCES who are members of TRS paid during the immediately preceding fiscal year.
7. The moneys in this Reserve Sub-Fund shall be deposited and secured in the manner provided by Section 10 of the General Municipal Law. The Board of Education or its authorized designee may invest the moneys in this Reserve Sub-Fund in the manner provided by Section 11 of the General Municipal Law. Any interest earned or capital gain realized on the money so deposited or invested shall accrue to and become part of this Reserve Sub-Fund.
8. The chief fiscal officer shall account for this Reserve Sub-Fund separate and apart from all other funds of the BOCES. Such accounting shall show: the source, date and amount of each sum paid into the sub-fund; the interest earned by such sub-fund; capital gains or losses resulting from the sale of investments of this sub-fund; the order, purpose thereof, date and amount of each payment from this sub-fund; the assets of the sub-fund, indicating cash balance and a schedule of investments. The chief fiscal officer, within sixty (60) days of the end of each fiscal year, shall furnish a detailed report of the operation and condition of this sub-fund to the Board of Education.
9. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
