

SUBJECT: SITE ACQUISITION

The District Superintendent, working with administrative staff and such other outside consultants as he/she may deem necessary, shall continuously monitor the availability of potential school sites within the BOCES. In determining the suitability of a site, reasonable consideration will be given to its educational adaptability, the environment, accessibility, and the initial and ultimate development costs.

Sites for the erection or enlargement of an educational facility shall comply with the requirements of, and be approved by the Commissioner, pursuant to Section 408(3) of the Education Law, and Article 1950 of the Education Law.

The Board will involve the BOCES Attorney in all stages leading to the acquisition of a school site.
